1. **A Maximum of 3 pieces** of student art from each educator, not from each class, **plus one artwork from the educator** (optional). **You are the curator...** we want this to be an exhibition that showcases the highest quality artwork created by Cape Cod students.
2. If you, as the instructor, decide to show an artwork of your own, you have the option to make it available to the public for sale. All proceeds from art sales will be divided as follows: 50% to the artist, 25% to the CCIAEA Scholarship Fund, 25% to the CCMoA. If you decide to take a smaller percentage, any additional proceeds will go toward the CCIAEA Scholarship Fund. Thank You!
3. Artwork should be properly framed and ready to hang. Works that are on paper and matted must have secure hangers on the back. **NO** taped-on wire or fishing line, as this type of support has proven to be insecure and items will fall off the wall and get damaged. 3-D items can be hung on the wall, set on pedestals (museum provides), secured in a display case (museum provides), or free standing.
4. We will be producing a virtual reception to debut on February 24th at 5:30 pm for you and your students to enjoy and be proud of! To accomplish this, we would like you to get a written statement, audio statement, or even better, a video clip, of your students explaining a little bit about themselves, their work, and why they like art. To be able to include the video clip, we will need a release form (provided) from the students' parents allowing us to use the clip on the Cape Cod Museum of Art website. **Parents, students or instructors can upload their statements via our upload portal: www.ccmoa.org/upload**
